

A MESSAGE FROM MATTHEW

My time at Burnside City Uniting Church

My pastoral ministry began in **November 2007** as I completed my theological degree with Supervised Field Education under the guidance of Reverend Donald Wilson. Before this I had spent 16 years in the mission fields of **Australia, Africa, India and the United States**. I returned to Adelaide in 1998 with Ruthmary (my wife), 4 small children and our 5th child was born soon after. We were a truly multi-national family with two of us born in Australia, two in Africa, two in Brazil and one in the USA. We all experienced a little bit of culture shock as we settled into life in South Australia. I paid the bills by driving a forklift for the first 12 months, we bought our own home and then I began 5 years of study at the **Adelaide College of Divinity**.

All of this was God's way of preparing me for ministry in the first 10 years of **Burnside City Uniting Church's** existence. In July 2018 our church will be 10 years old! God knew that what I had experienced in 16 different countries, while living by faith, trusting God for the next meal or place to sleep, would be the perfect preparation for the years ahead. Now I would say that "Expect the unexpected" is the advice I needed at the time. My time at BCUC began with Youth Ministry, School Chaplaincy and Pastoral duties in the church and the prayer I prayed regularly was "Dear God, please guide me through the various challenges we will face together today!"

In 2012 my role changed dramatically as I became the Ministry Team Leader and my responsibilities increased yet again. This was a time of exciting changes as our church continued to grow together from 4 neighbourhood churches into one larger church. We learned how to do ministry together and we saw many new people join the church during these years. We began to say, "We are one church now."

Now, as we stand on the edge of new beginnings we may wonder what God has planned for us? As I go to Spicer Memorial Uniting Church to begin a new chapter in my ministry and BCUC commences the process of calling new ministers, I would like to leave you with these well-known words from Jeremiah 29:11-14a

"For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. Then you will call on me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart. I will be found by you".

May the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with us all.
